Pollution

From January 1st 2015, new UK waste regulations will require businesses to separate recyclable material (paper, plastic, metal and glass) from other waste. This amendment to the EU Waste Framework Directive is to ensure improvement to the quality and quantity of recycling across the UK. The Environment Agency is the body to enforce these regulations in England.

Pollution claims clean up costs cover

We will pay your loss for pollution clean up costs for any claim and/ or investigation made against you. The most we will pay under this cover is £25,000 for any one claim. This is also the most we will pay for all loss of documents claims in any one period of insurance.
